Subjects are available at Standard Level (SL) and Higher Level (HL) unless labeled as HL or SL

Please highlight one subject in each option to indicate your preferred subject in that column. For the full IB Diploma you will need to choose at least one language A, one language B, one Maths course, one science and one humanities subject. Both Computer Science and SEHS are science subjects. ESS is **both** a science and a humanities subject. To qualify for the full Diploma you cannot take more than three SL subjects.

Please return this form to Mr. Robinson no later than Monday 29th February.

Students will be able to change subjects and levels in September – and beyond in some circumstances. However if a subject has no students enrolled it may be withdrawn as an option and if a class has 15 students (our maximum class size) any student wanting to join that class will be put on a waiting list.
