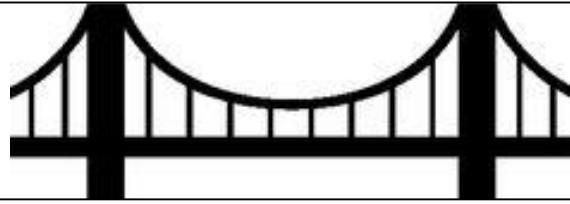


BISI Engineering Week
