

2020 IGCSE Results Analysis for Year 11

This year, the statistics are based on the grades awarded by Cambridge International, following a four-stage statistical standardisation process so that the distribution of grades awarded this year is consistent with those awarded in other years globally. The process started with the submission of predicted grades, which were the best assessment of what our teachers thought candidates would have achieved if the exams had taken place.

The aim of the standardisation process was to ensure fairness and consistency between students in different years and in different schools, and to make sure this year's grades are as valid as in any other year.

Despite this adversity, anxiety and uncertainty caused by the outbreak of COVID 19, students have done well, highlighting the importance of consistent hard work and focus, a good working ethic over the duration of the two-year course.

Award of the International Certificate in Education

The Cambridge ICE certificate is a group award given at:

<i>Distinction</i>	Grade A/A* in five or more subjects
<i>Merit</i>	Grade A*/C in five or more subjects
<i>Pass</i>	Grade A*/G in seven subjects.

To qualify students must take at least seven subjects, including two from Group I and one or more from each of the other groups. This year 5 students did not have the correct combination of subjects and did not qualify for this award.

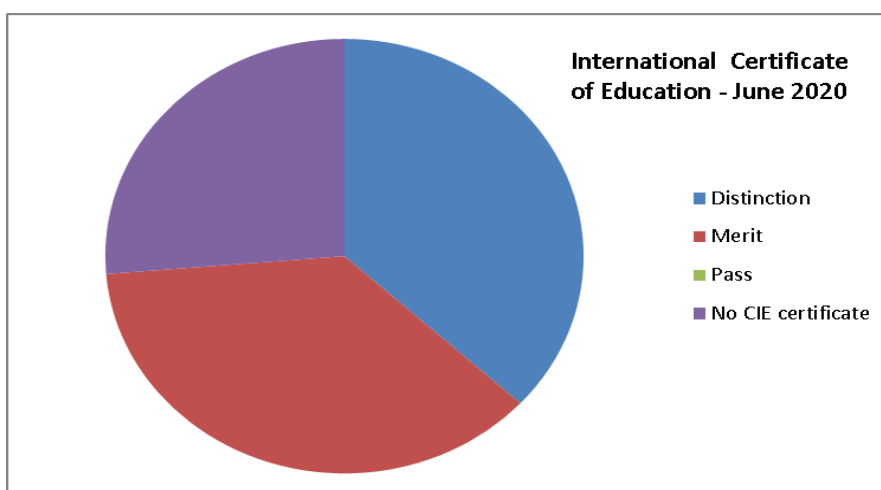
Of the 14 students qualifying for this award:

50% students achieved DISTINCTION in the International Certificate of Education / 5 A* - A

50% students achieved MERIT in the International Certificate of Education / 5 A* - C

5 students were not entered for the ICE awards due to subject choices.

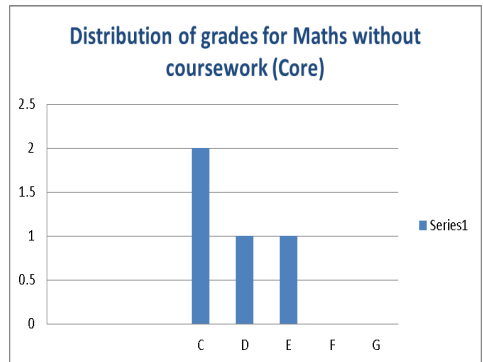
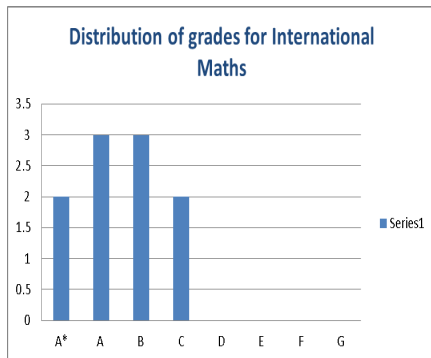
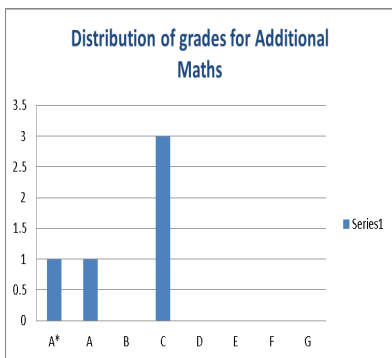
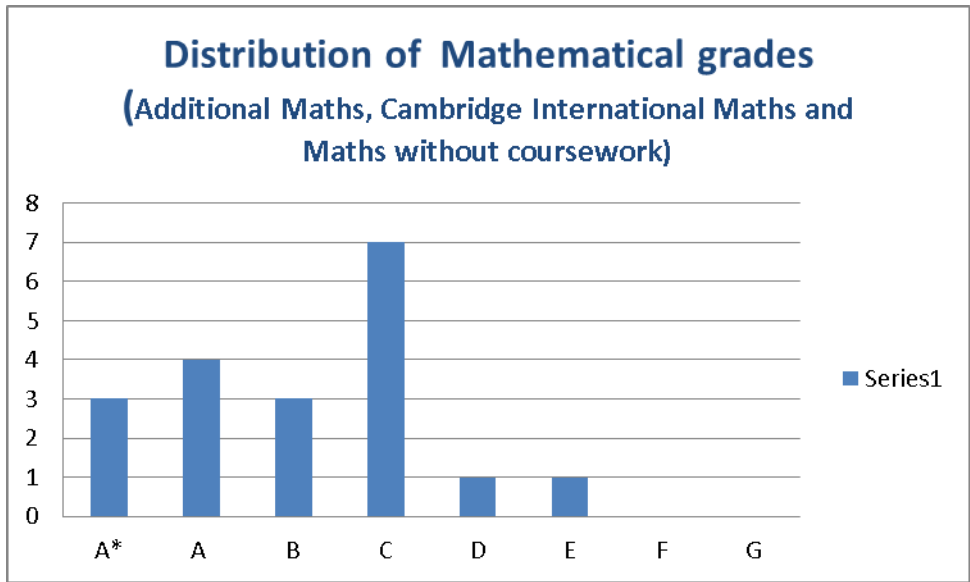

Pass rates in English and Mathematics

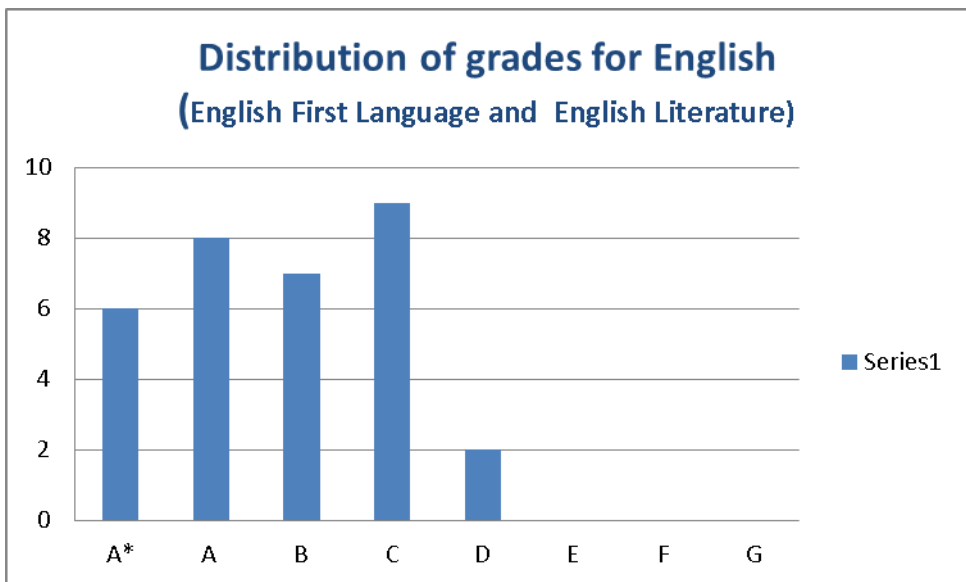
89.4% of all Maths students (Additional Maths, Cambridge International Maths and Maths without coursework) passed Mathematics with A*-C grades.

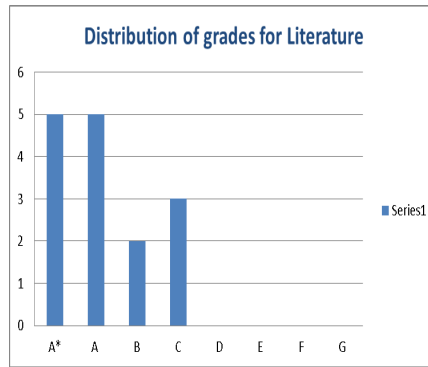
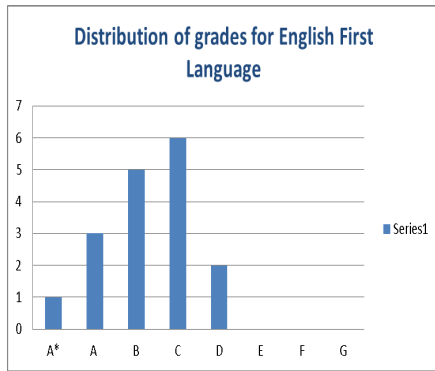
100% of Additional Mathematics students have a grade A*/C

All of our students who studied English Literature achieved 100% A*/A- C grades, and 66.6% achieved A*/A grades.



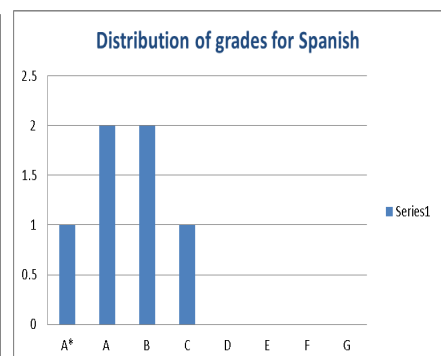
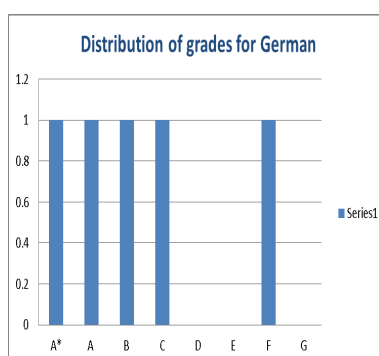
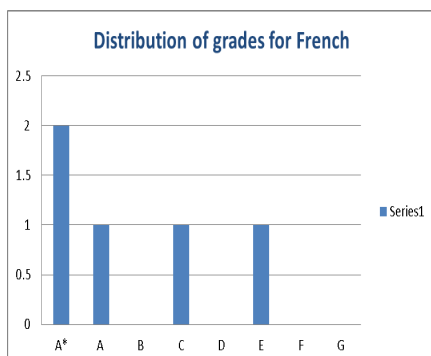
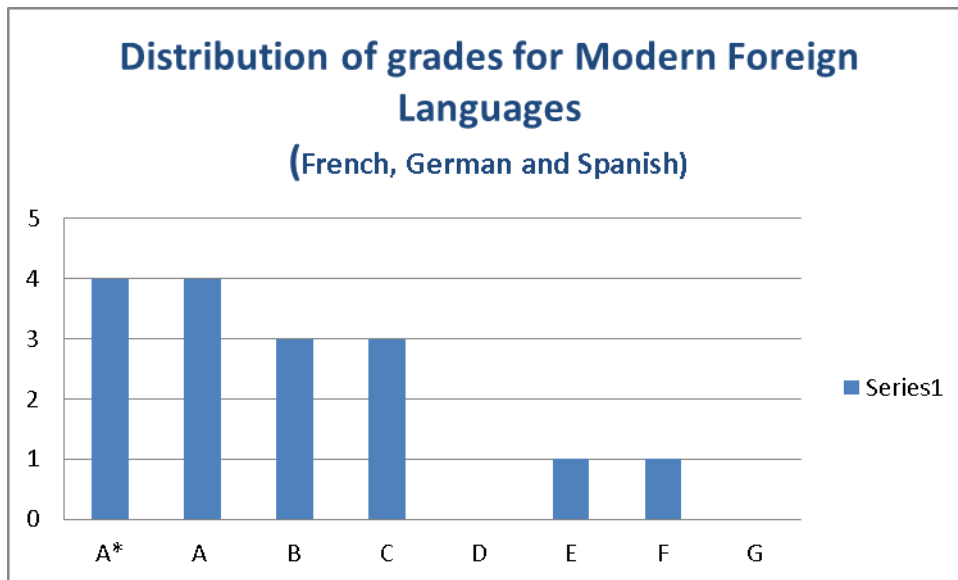


Subject Group Analysis

87.5% of all foreign language grades awarded resulted in a pass A*-C grade and 50% of these were awarded at A*/A.

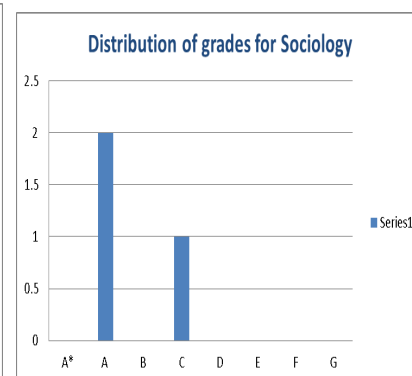
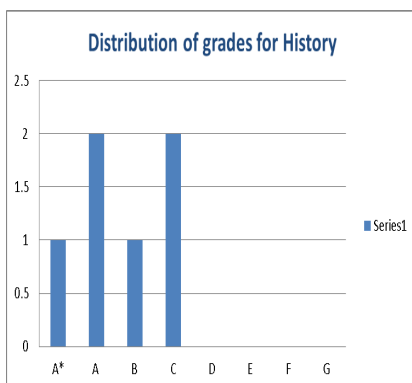
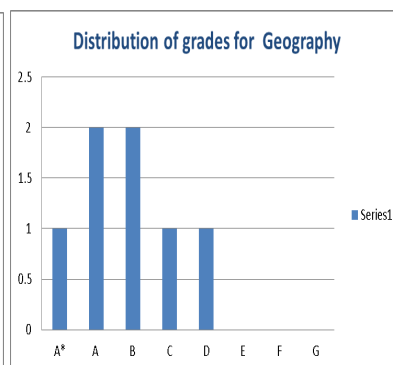
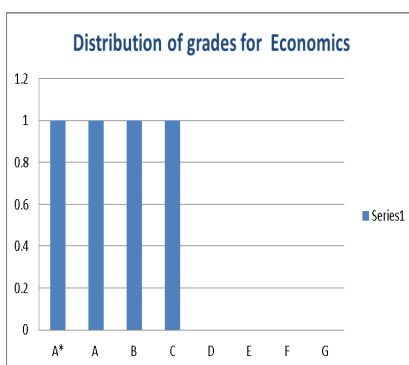
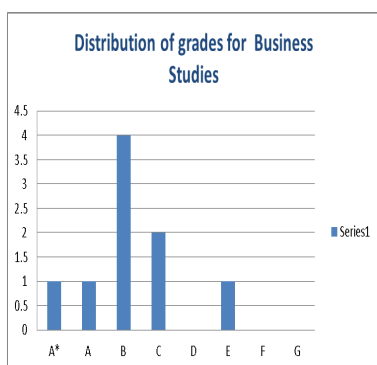
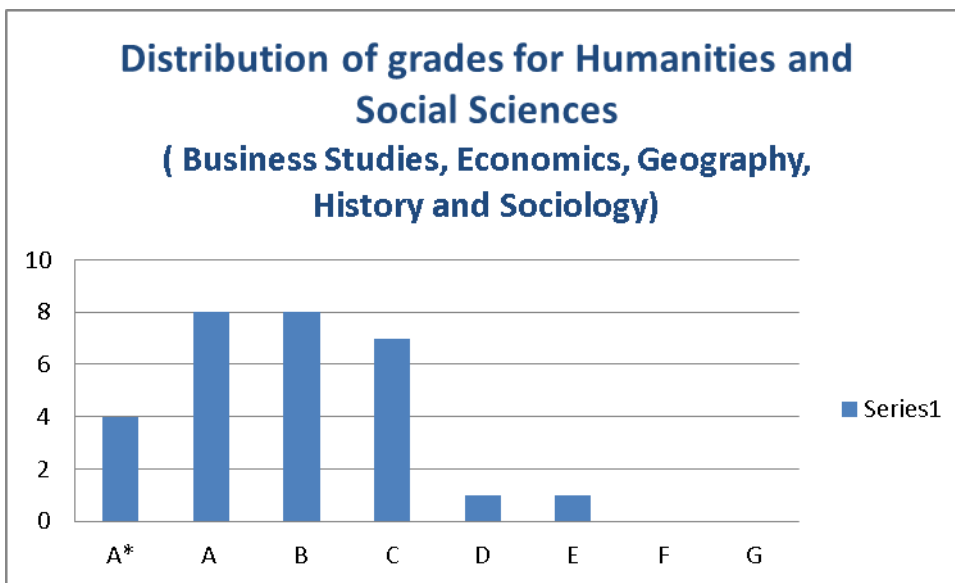


Grades and Pass rates in Humanities & Social Sciences

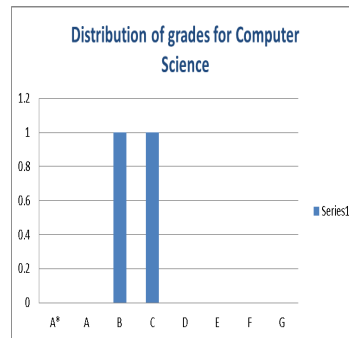
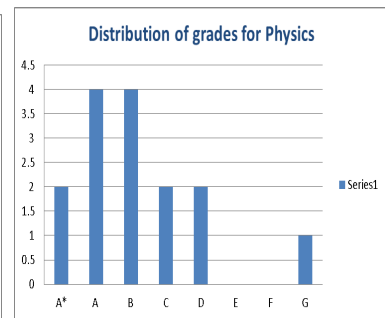
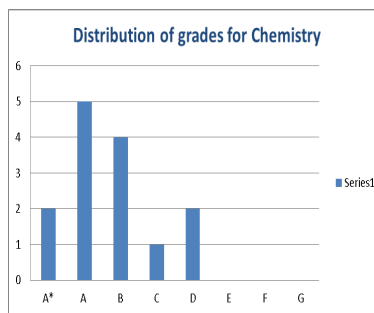
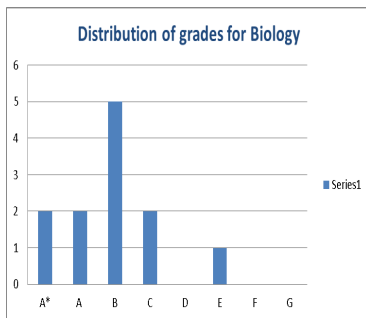
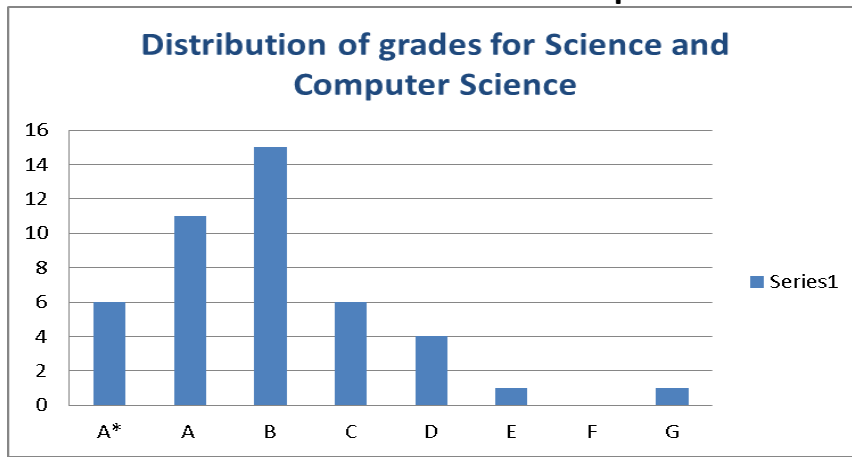


Grades and Pass rates in Science

Grades Awarded in Science and Computer Science

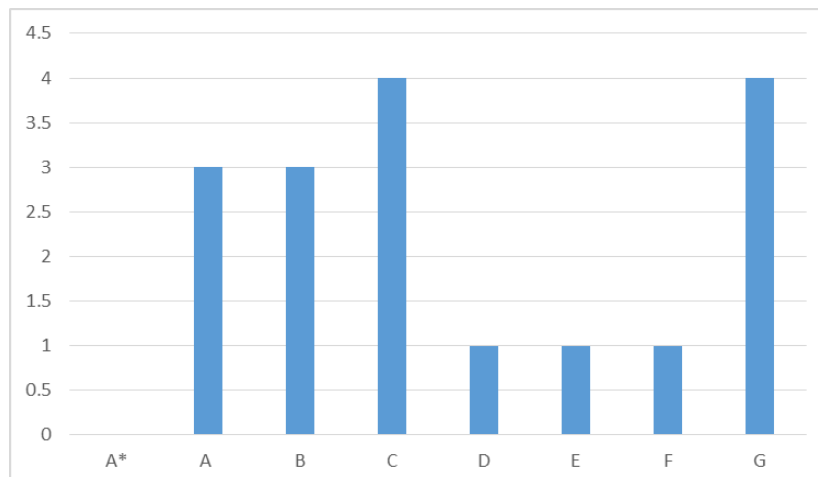


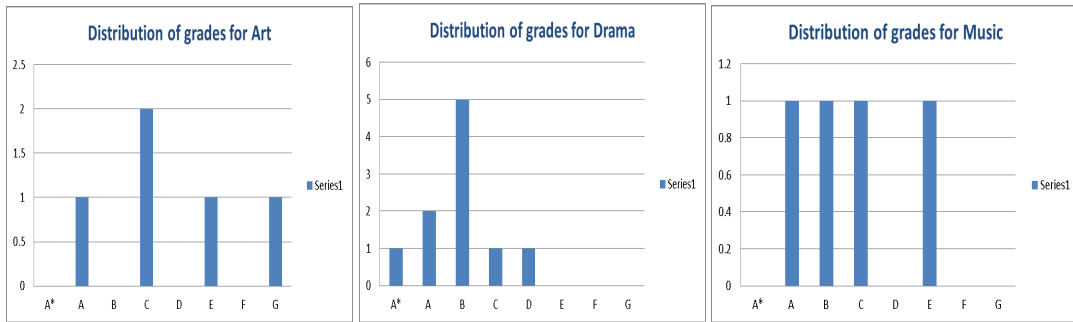
Grades and Pass rates in the Arts

Grades Awarded in Art

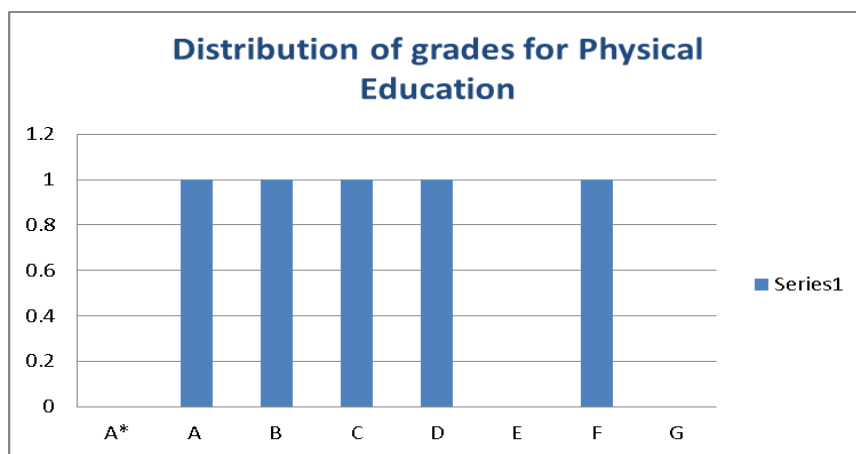




Grades and Pass rates in Physical Education

Grades and Pass rates in English as a Second Language

This was taken at Core and Extended level

70% of the students were awarded a pass in this subject - A*-C grades

Grades and Pass rates in Foreign Languages

These are students who take exams in their home language or a language they master well.

This year we had one student taking a Foreign Language one year early who was awarded an A*.

Grades and Pass rates in Drama

Exceptionally this year we had one student studying Drama one year early who was awarded a B.
